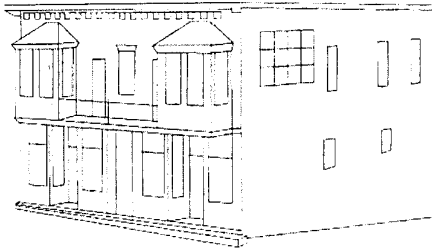

RE: *Demand for Recount of County of Marin, Flood Control District, Zone 9  
Ballot on "Storm Drainage Fee" the Board of Supervisors and/or the  
Board of Supervisors acting as the Marin County Flood Control And Water

Dear Officials:

I am the property owner for A.P. 006-083-08 which has been putatively assessed at a yearly fee-tax rate increase in the amount of \$287.46.

In the above referenced "election" held between May 5 and June 25, 2007, I voted "No" in order to reject the measure.

The reasons I rejected it, and why I now seek a recount included, but were and are not limited to, the following:

1. The total failure to provide adequate notice to the electorate by depicting what is, in fact, a 20 year \$40 million property tax falsely as a "fee";
2. The failure to engage in a sufficiently specific calculation of the amount of the fee-tax each property owner would be required to pay;



3. By imposing a fee-tax on property owners who would receive no direct benefit from the fee-tax;
  4. By forcing property owners to pay the fee-tax that would directly benefit others who are at risk from flood damage;
  5. By exempting governmental agencies, churches and a multitude of other entities and persons similarly situated with the ordinary tax payers like I am from having any responsibility to pay their fair share;
  6. By failing to adequately describe, account for and control the manner in which such funds would be expended;
  7. By disguising the initial mailer as “junk mail,” so as to minimize the opportunity of the voters to nip this ploy in the bud;
  8. By proceeding in such a manner the resulted in no opportunity for effective public argument against and discussion regarding the measure;
  9. By requiring a signature of each ballot which is completely inconsistent with all other voting practices that have been conducted over the years and with which the voters are consequently familiar;
  10. By having the department (public works) that stands the most to benefit by the authorization of over \$40 million be the entity for evaluating and counting the vote; and
  11. By the rank discard of almost 25% of the voters who responded to the mail-in ballot in making the decision that the voters “approved” said fee-tax.

Based on all of the above reasons, jointly and severally, pursuant to Educations Code section 15620, I hereby demand a recount of the above election.

Because the election has been flawed in all of the ways I have identified above, I hereby demand that said recount be conducted **FREE OF CHARGE** so as to help remove the taint of interest and impropriety that stains said election results.

I am directing the demand for a recount to each of you because I am not sure who, in fact, is responsible for this election and I want to make sure you do not approve without challenge according to some "technicality" that reflects respect for a trick rather than a respect for the will of us, the voters.
